Business driven problem-based learning for
academic excellence in geoinformatics / GEOBIZ

Third LLL course at University of Tirana

Faculty of History and Philology organized on May 27th-28th, 2022, the third LLL course in GIS (Geographic Information Systems), in the framework of the GEOBIZ project – “*Problem-based and business-oriented learning to achieve academic excellence in Geoinformatics*” co-financed by the Erasmus + Program of the EU.

The LLL course: “*Analysing spatial patterns of noise in urban areas by mapping*”, which was attended by 24 participants, was led by Prof. asoc. Dr. Sonila Papatimi.

In this training, participants received theoretical information and practiced noise mapping and analyses with ready to use data collected in the urban areas of Tirana. Participants also practiced collecting and processing noise measurements with their own mobile devices. The purpose of the two case studies used for training was to identify ways to collect noise data in urban areas and analyze them through maps created in ArcGIS or QGIS. This training enhances the professional skills of participants, which they can apply in their workplaces and future studies.

At the end of the training, all participants were provided with a certificate.
